## What we are working on

Reading: Readers learned to compare and contrast different elements within a fiction text.

Skills: In skills, students learned to recognize and use different long i sound spelling patterns.

Math: Mathematicians modeled numbers with 1 more and 1 less, 10 more and 10 less, and 100 more and 100 less when changing the hundreds place.

Writing: Writers learned to identify and use clauses that begin with 'when' to change simple sentences into complex sentences and add important details and conditions. They made memory books, using the clause "When I was little," to show their understanding.

Social Studies: To show their understanding of the differences and likenesses of rural, suburban, and urban communities, students wrote fictional narratives from the perspective of an object in a specific type of community using key features of that community.
