What we are working on

Reading: Students₁ are learning to read and comprehend scientific/technological nonfiction texts. As they deciphered the text, students identified the main idea and supporting details. To synthesize their learning, they answered questions about the topic using evidence from the text.

Skills: This week we identified and used the plural endings -s and -es.

Math: MathematiCians apply their understanding of place value strategies to the subtraction algorithm, moving from concrete to pictorial to abstract.

Writing: Writers continued to gather information about wolves to write information paragraphs, using details from their notes.

Science: Scientists observed their growing plants. After determining what plants need to grow, students devised an experiment to prove their hypothesis that plants need oxygen, light, and water.
