## What we are working on

Reading: Students continued to compare and contrast two or more versions of the same story by different authors or from different cultures to learn how to identify similarities and differences. This week we used two versions of Cinderella.

Skills: Students learned to recognize and use compound words.
Writing: Writers used their knowledge of fairy tales to create their own. By the end of the week they created goals for themselves and published their stories before sharing them with the class.

Math: Mathematicians learned to use the associative property to subtract from three-digit numbers and verify solutions with addition, Reviewed strategies for varied addition and subtraction problems within 1,000.

Science/Social Studies: This week the focus was on understanding that communities change and grow overtime depending on the demands of the community.
