What we are working on

Reading: Students, had a reteach week focusing on how Characters respond to major events and Challenges in a story and providing textual evidence. Students also worked on identifying the theme of a story.

Skills: Students recognized that a contraction is a short way of saying or writing two words. Students learned the strategy of using an apostrophe to take the place of letters dropped when forming a contraction
