What we are working on

Reading: Students learned to recognize story elements: setting, characters, problem, events, solution.

Skills: We continued working with long vowels. The focus was on long a and long i patterns.

Math: Mathematicians continued using their knowledge of basic facts and place value to add within 100. We tackled place value to compose and decompose numbers. They also reviewed odd and even numbers and took their module assessment.

Writing: Writers continued working with connected sentences. This week the focus was using proper nouns. We created a class flip book of super sentences.

Science: This week we switched to science. The first lesson was on understanding the scientific method. We started science with the unit on Earth Materials: rocks, water and soil. The students learned that all materials have properties.


